

How to become a “sponsor” of Building the Future

If you want to support this project, you could

- ✓ Make a one-off donation
- ✓ Commit to regular weekly donations for up to 5 years
- ✓ Commit to regular monthly donations for up to 5 years
- ✓ Commit to regular annual donations for up to 5 years

If you are a taxpayer, you can gift aid your donation - it costs you nothing extra, but the project benefits by up to 25%. Simply complete and return the enclosed Gift Aid form.

Am I committed to giving for the 5 years of the project?

No, you can stop or change your giving at any time. However, it helps our project planning to know your intentions.

How can I give to the project?

You could send a cheque to the church treasurer or complete a banker's order form (see enclosed) or ask for special envelopes which can be handed in with the regular offering at church services.

When can I start giving my donations?

As soon as you like!

Here's what we want to do ...

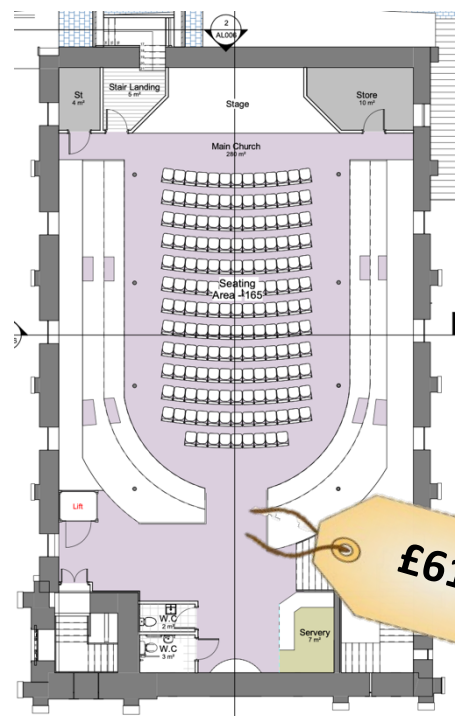
Phase 1:
Kitchen
upgrade

£50K

Phase 2: new glass entrance
community rooms on ground floor

Other costs:

Hall entrance: £170K
Furniture etc: £50K
AV equip: £50K
Fees: £130K
Window repairs: £85K
Landscaping: £50K
Contingencies: £150K

Here's how we can achieve it ...

- we have £500K
- we are applying for £500K in grants
- fundraising £50K
- we still need £300K



We are committed to a bright vision for the future of our building, which will make it fit for congregation and community well into the 21st century.

To do so will cost a lot of money - more than can be raised by the usual fundraising activities. We are approaching some major funding bodies who we hope will make significant grants, but ultimately this project will require **everyone's** help. That is why we are inviting you to become a **"sponsor"** by contributing to the project financially.

Becoming a "sponsor" is open to church members, or to other interested folk from Selkirk or beyond, who want to support our project.

With enough "sponsors" giving support, however large or small, we can make this project succeed.

Here's how it could work:

- ✓ 100 people giving £1 per week = £25,000 over 5 years
- ✓ 50 people giving £5 per month = £15,000 over 5 years
- ✓ 40 people giving £10 per month = £24,000 over 5 years
- ✓ 30 one-off donations of £50 each year = £7,500 over 5 years
- ✓ 20 one-off donations of £500 = £10,000
- ✓ 10 one-off donations of £1,000 = £10,000
- ✓ 5 one-off donations of £5,000 = £25,000

Added together, that comes to £116,000. With Gift Aid, that could increase to around £160,000, which would fill more than half the gap.
